Francisco Eraso DDS, MS, MS, MSD

Dr. Eraso is an Oral and Maxillofacial Radiologist and an Orthodontist. He received his D.D.S. from Pontificia Universidad Javeriana, Bogotá, Colombia, his advanced standing dental degree from Indiana University School of Dentistry, his M.S. in Oral Biology from the University of Louisville, his certificate and M.S. in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology from The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and his Orthodontic Certificate and M.S.D from Indiana University.

Currently Dr. Eraso is an Adjunct Associate Professor in the Department of Orthodontics at Indiana University; practice Orthodontics and is part owner of the Oral and Maxillofacial Imaging Centers – Indianapolis & Chicago.

Dr. Eraso contributes as a reviewer for the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics, Angle Orthodontics, the Journal of Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology, Oral Radiology & Endodontics and the Journal of Dentomaxillofacial Radiology. He has published several papers in the field and lectured at various professional meetings and continued education courses nationally and internationally. Dr. Eraso is a member of numerous professional societies including: American Dental Association, American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, International Association of Dentomaxillofacial Radiology and the American Association of Orthodontists.

Dr. Eraso's areas of interest include digital imaging and 3D reconstruction, teleradiology and advanced imaging for Orthodontics, TMJ and Implants.

Martin D. Levin DMD

Dr. Levin graduated from Emory University in 1968, and earned his degree in dental medicine from the University of Pennsylvania in 1972, where he was a member of the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Honor Society. After completing his post-doctoral residency in endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania, he became a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics and a member of the College of Diplomates.

He is a recognized expert, speaking both nationally and internationally on diagnosis, three-dimensional computed tomography, digital radiography, treatment planning, clinical techniques and advanced endodontic technologies. At the University of Pennsylvania, School of Dental Medicine, he received the Alumni Award of Merit, served as Chair of the Board of Overseers from 2004-2008, and remains a member of the board. Dr. Levin is an Adjunct Associate Professor of Endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania, School of Dental Medicine, Adjunct Associate Professor, Department of Endodontics, Nova Southeastern University, College of Dental Medicine. At the University of Maryland, College of Dental Medicine, he is Clinical Associate Professor in the Division of Endodontics. He is a contributor to the 8th, 9th and 10th Editions of "Pathways of the Pulp" and the 6th Edition of "Ingle's Endodontics," as well as author of numerous peer-reviewed articles. He serves as Director of EndoNet Consulting, LLC.

He is a Specialist Member of the American Association of Endodontists, an Affiliate Member of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, the American Dental Association, the District of Columbia Dental Society and the Maryland State Dental Society.

Sharon L. Brooks DDS, MS

Title: "To the new generation – words from your big sister"

In this lecture Dr. Brooks will reflect on her long career as an oral and maxillofacial radiologist and offer words of advice/wisdom to the newer radiologists in the AAOMR family, drawing also on the perspectives of others of her generation, to help others have as much success and enjoyment in their careers as she has had in hers.

Dr. Brooks received all of her education at the University of Michigan, BA Ed (1965), DDS (1973), MS (Oral Diagnosis and Radiology, 1976), MS (Radiological Health, 1984), MS (Clinical Research Design and Statistical Analysis, 1989). She became a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology in 1984 – on her 40th birthday! She has served the Academy in many ways over the years, including being President (2001-2003). She also was a Director of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology from 2004-2008, serving as President in 2008. She was editor of the oral radiology section of Oral Surgery Oral Medicine Oral Pathology Oral Radiology Endodontics from 1995-2001 and has been editor of Dentomaxillofacial Radiology since 2003. She is currently Professor Emerita at the University of Michigan, having recently retired from the university.

Dale A. Miles BA, DDS, MS, FRCD(C) Dip. ABOMR, Dip. ABOM

Title: "A Case of Mistaken Identity!": Consequences of "missed pathology" in Cone Beam Scans

BIO

Until recently, Dr. Miles was a Professor of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs at the Arizona School of Dentistry & Oral Health (ASDOH). He still holds an adjunct professorship in oral and maxillofacial radiology with the Arizona school. Previously he has been Chair of the Department of Oral Health Sciences at the University of Kentucky, the graduate program director of Dental Diagnostic Sciences at Indiana University, and has held positions at the University of Connecticut and Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He is a Diplomate of both the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and the American Board of Oral Medicine. Dr. Miles received his Bachelor of Arts and his Doctor of Dental Surgery degrees at the University of Western Ontario in London, Canada. After practicing general dentistry for 6 years he attended the University of Texas where he attained his Certificate in Dental Diagnostic Sciences (1982), and Master of Science degree in Dental Diagnostic Sciences from the UTHSCSA Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences in 1983.

Dr. Miles has been a test construction consultant for the National Dental Examining Board for the ADA. He has been named as one of the "TOP CLINICANS IN CE" for the past 8 years by Dentistry Today. He has authored over 130 scientific articles and five textbooks, including the latest textbook on Cone Beam Imaging by Quintessence. Dr. Miles received the "Civism" award from the Department of the United States Navy in 2002, the highest civilian award the USN can bestow. He also received the University of Western Ontario School of Dentistry "Alumni of Distinction" award in 2003.

David C. Hatcher, D.D.S., M.Sc., M.R.C.D.(c)

Title: "lopsided Lucy and other like her"

Dr. Hatcher received his D.D.S. degree from the University of Washington in 1973. Subsequently he completed two years active duty in the U.S. Public Health Service and a one year general practice residency program at the University of Vermont Medical Center. Following three years as an instructor and one year as acting director of the general practice residency and the hospital dental clinical at the University of Washington, Dr. Hatcher entered the graduate program in radiology at the University of Toronto and was granted a specialty degree in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology in 1982 and an M.Sc. in 1983. His thesis topic dealt with radiology of temporomandibular dysfunction. Dr. Hatcher was an Associate Professor and Chairman of the Division of Radiology for five years at the University of Alberta, Canada. He was also Director of the Temporomandibular Joint Investigation Unit and Clinic while at the University of Alberta. Presently Dr. Hatcher is in private practice in Sacramento, California and has faculty appointments at University of Southern Nevada, University of California San Francisco and the University of Pacific Dental Schools.
